Warren Neidich's show at Glenn Horowitz Bookseller closes this weekend



If you're looking for some culture and an investigation of patriotism with your sun this holiday weekend, try artist [Warren Neidich](#) <sup>[2]</sup>'s gorgeous show at [Glenn Horowitz Bookseller](#) <sup>[3]</sup>, a bookstore and gallery in East Hampton, New York. The central piece is a handsome steel bookshelf fashioned after a Constructivist aesthetic that houses all of the books Sarah Palin attempted to have banned from the Wasilla, Alaska, library. Whether or not these attempts at banning were successful is unknown; however, Neidich has enabled us to exert some control and rewrite history a bit in our own fashion: The participatory piece invites locals, over the course of the exhibition, to visit the bookstore bearing a red book and exchange it for one of the verboten. From 3 to 5pm today, there will be a book release for Neidich's new artist's book, *The Sarah L. Palin Library of Censored Books*. *Fri, Sat, Mon 10am–5pm; Sun noon–4pm. Through Monday, July 5.*
